A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

When we confess our faith using the Apostle's Creed we confess the identity and work of God. In the third article we say what we believe about the Holy Spirit, who is the third person of the Holy Trinity saying: "We believe in the Holy Christian Church, the Communion of Saints…" These confessions mean that we believe that God has not only made us his own, but that **God** has made us each other's.

In the Small Catechism Martin Luther explains the third article of the creed this way: "I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Ghost has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith; even as He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the (continued)

one true faith; in which Christian Church He forgives daily and richly all sins to me and all believers, and at the last day will raise up me and all the dead, and will give to me and to all believers in Christ everlasting life. This is most certainly true. "We believe that God, of his own will and for our blessing calls each of us to him, and then calls all of us together. That means that **we are God's gift to each other.** Our fellowship is not happenstance, it is God's work and God's will. Do you treat all of the people in your life as part of God's plan for you? Do you see them all as God's gift to you? This is what we confess as God's people.

We are seeing some new faces crop up lately at Trinity. Rae Harris our new Communication Coordinator is a gift of God to help us get and stay connected with each other and our community here in Ashland! Rev. 



# COUNCIL — NOTES & NEWS

#### **COUNCIL COMMITTEE UPDATES FROM THE FEBRUARY MEETING**

**Pastor's Remarks:** Pastor Kevin reflected on the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection as we approach Easter. He encouraged us to consider the glory to come and how new life arises only after loss.

**Staff:** Georg Warneke is expected to arrive around April 8th, and lodging needs to be secured for him. Staff meetings are now held on Tuesday mornings. Rae Harris, the new Communications Coordinator, has started and is doing well.

**Finance:** Approval sought for finance committee members to have viewer-level access to QuickBooks Online. Transfers from Clark Fund to cover 2023 operating deficit, NALC support payment timing issue, and reimbursing Outreach Fund from Rybolt Fund.

**Kitchen:** 38 Ashland County Cancer Association meal vouchers used in February, partnering again in March for up to 110 vouchers. Jeff Gray recognized for quickly resolving ice maker drain issue.

Montessori School: Still looking for a new teacher.

**Outreach:** Still need someone to fill the vacant spot. New grant agreement to be signed with Windham Volunteer Fire Department.

**Personnel:** Bookkeeper interviews ongoing. New employee handbook accepted. Interviews for Director of Christian Development position upcoming. Staff evaluations completed.

**Property:** Discussing authorizations to hire contractors for basement classroom renovations after drainage work. Request to power wash walkways and walls, with cost estimates provided. April 13th work day, need volunteers to clean garage and build shelves.

**Women and Children:** Successful Mother Daughter Tea with over 60 attending. Girls Night Out Bunco night had over 30 women. VBS planning underway after a positive workshop.
