

Operation Christmas Child Packing Party: A Night of Generosity & Global Impact



What an incredible night! On November 10th, Trinity's community came together with one mission: to bring hope, joy, and the message of Jesus to children around the world through our Operation Christmas Child Packing Party. Together, families, friends, and small groups packed 467 shoeboxes, each filled with love and thoughtful gifts, with even more boxes still being packed. After an inspiring time of packing, everyone celebrated with Chipotle—a fitting end to a night focused on giving back.

This event was especially meaningful for the children in our congregation, who had the chance to hand-pick items for children their own age. From toys to school supplies to hygiene essentials, each box is a gift that not only brings joy to the recipient but also a message of love and hope in Jesus. For many of these children, this shoebox may be the first gift they've ever received, and it's a tangible reminder that they are seen, loved, and valued by God.

Operation Christmas Child, a project of Samaritan's Purse, has been filling shoeboxes for children in need since 1993. What began as a single act of kindness has now become a global movement that has delivered over 220 million shoeboxes to children in more than 170 countries. Each box represents an opportunity for children to learn about Jesus, often for the very first time. Local churches partner with Samaritan's Purse to present these gifts at festive outreach events, sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in a meaningful and unforgettable way.

The impact of a simple shoebox is extraordinary, and through it, Trinity is living out the Great Commission. Jesus said, "Let the children come to Me" (Mark 10:14), and every box we pack is a step toward making disciples of all nations. Thank you to each person who contributed to this mission. Your generosity is lighting up lives and pointing children around the world to the hope of Christ. This Christmas, Trinity has truly embodied the spirit of giving, showing that every act of kindness, no matter how small, has the power to change lives.

COUNCIL REPORT: NOVEMBER 2024 MEETING

Meeting Highlights

Pastor's Opening Reflection

Pastor Kevin reflected on the Thanksgiving holiday, urging the council to consider gratitude and love as a foundation for all gatherings, inviting them to experience "holy days" through fellowship and connection to God

Approval of Minutes

Kenny Oberholtzer moved to accept the previous meeting's minutes, seconded by Jenny. The motion was carried unanimously.

Staff Updates

- Joellen is gradually recovering and plans to work limited hours starting mid-December.
- Rae Harris will be leaving her position on December 12th.

Old Business

- Pastor Georg Warneke, who previously served at Trinity, expressed interest in returning for a
 four-week volunteer service next summer, with only flight and lodging expenses required. A
 decision on this will require advance planning and budget considerations.
- Strategic Leadership Team decisions are paused until the new year. A subcommittee was formed to rework the team list and advance the process.

Christian Education

- No Sunday School classes on November 24.
- A "Birthday Party for Jesus" will replace regular classes on December 22, with a lesson, music, and activities for children. Efforts are underway to create a substitute list for Sunday School teachers.

Finance Committee

- Approved the mailing of year-end giving letters for December 9, with the 2025 budget process on track. A special Church Council meeting is scheduled for December 3 to review the budget, with approval anticipated on December 10.
- The Finance Committee suggested a special congregational meeting to approve the 2025 budget on January 26.
- Plans to address projected deficits of \$150K for 2024 and \$300K for 2025 using designated funds, including Bequest, Memorials, and other specific reserves.
- Council approved moving monthly meetings to the third Tuesday starting in January 2025 to allow more accurate financial reporting.

Finance Committee (Continued)

• Motion carried to remove former employee Kate Strine from the Farmers State Bank accounts.

Property and Grounds

- Choir loft flooring and electrical estimates are underway.
- A spring mulch delivery, awarded through a fundraiser, was announced.

Outreach and Missions

 Trinity will cover half the costs for members attending a SONetwork Bible Camp in 2025, funded by the Outreach Fund.

Personnel Committee

- Council approved the hiring of Gage Garlinghouse, a seminary student, as an intern to assist with administrative tasks and reside in the church apartment.
- The Director of Communications position remains open.
- A new custodian has been provided by Ohio Pro Clean following the resignation of Charles Roberts.

Worship and Music

- Upcoming performances and rehearsals were highlighted, including the Men's Chorus, High Praise, and Christmas musical preparations.
- Special holiday services, including Thanksgiving Eve and Christmas Eve, are planned with broad participation from members of all ages.

Youth Ministry

- High school Sunday School attendance remains strong. Upcoming youth events were outlined, with the first event scheduled for December 18.
- Ryane Briggs is forming a youth committee and planning an outreach to youth and parents.

Women and Children

- Operation Christmas Child and the Advent Workshop are set for December, along with the Women's Christmas Brunch.
- Kristen McClain was hired as the Nursery Coordinator, overseeing care during services.

Adjournment

• The meeting concluded with a motion to adjourn and was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
